Clarifications & Revisions

Question 1:

To request clarification on Eligibility and Qualification Table, Section 4.1 (a) "Consultant has a track record of working experience under ICAO and/or IATA planning and design standards.

Submit a list of at least 8 project references under the standards for work completed and in-progress in past 10 years".

If interpreted literally, this could disqualify U.S. firms. As you are aware, all airport regulations are rooted in ICAO regulations that must be adopted by the Civil Aviation Authorities (CAA) of each ICAO-member country. In Jamaica, that CAA is the Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority and in the U.S., that agency is the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

Therefore, all of the highly experienced U.S. firms have been required by law to meet local Building Codes and FAA design standards, which by inference the latter are those of ICAO. We wanted to confirm therefore that such U.S. companies would nonetheless be in with the EOI requirements, particularly since our team will consist of local Jamaica airport SME's adept in the knowledge of such ICAO planning and design standards. **Please confirm**.

RESPONSE:

The EOI recognises that Consultants are likely to be admitted from various countries / continents; working in the field of aviation under varying jurisdictions. Naming the individual aviation regulatory body of each would not be beneficial.

It is the thus the responsibility of the Consultant to demonstrate that they have a track record of working experience under ICAO and/or IATA planning and design standards. Submit a list of at least 8 project references under the standards for work completed and in-progress in the past 10 years.

- (i) a "reputable financial institution" and
- (ii) the content of the letter of support required

RESPONSE:

(i) a "reputable financial institution" and

<u>Financial institution</u> means any financial intermediary or other enterprise that is authorized to do business and regulated or supervised as a financial institution under the law of the Contracting Party in whose territory it is located.

For example: The Financial Institution Act Jamaica.

Authorized Financial Institutions in Jamaica are defined in this Act as those regulated by the:

- a) Banking Act, 1992; or
- b) Financial Institutions Act, 1992; or



- c) Building Societies Act, 1897; or
- d) Financial Services Act, 2001
- (ii) the content of the letter of support required
 - Acknowledgement of Applicant as Client of the Financial Institution
 - Expression of support for the Applicant's Business Venture & Cash flow requirements.

Question 4.
